

## Academy Hill Cemetery

**Location:** Academy Hill Rd., Lot 22 Con. 2

**Number of Burials (2011):** 124

Academy Hill Cemetery was established in 1813. James Dubois leased the property for one pound and five shillings for 999 years. Before 1840, a schoolhouse was built on cemetery grounds. It is sometimes known as Massey Cemetery as there are many Massey's buried here. The first burial was Samuel Massey who died June 3, 1813.

Pioneer families include: **Allen, Boland, Bradley, Crouter, Eddy, Fishfraser, Irish, Kellar, Lapp, Massey, Masters, Noble(s), Merrill, Merriam, Moore, Richardson, Robinson, Sargent, Shaw, Stewart, Taylor, Tucker, Vaughan, Wait and Winter**

Academy Hill Cemetery has been designated as a **heritage property**. It is maintained by the Alnwick/Haldimand Township Heritage Cemeteries Advisory Board.
