Location: 118 Aird Street, Grafton Village. Lot 23 Con. 1

Number of Burials (2011): 58

This cemetery contains the graves of some of Grafton's earliest settlers. The earliest known burial was Hannah Boyce d. May 27, 1831 (21yrs) w/o Nelson Boyce. The last was Daniel D. Jayne d. Nov.21, 1913 (81 yrs).
